May 10, 2006: Camera-ready version of the accepted papers (MS Word file), registration form and fee are due.

REGISTRATION FEES

Full registration fee: 150 EURO for early registration (10 May 2005) and **200 EURO** for late registration.

Student registration fee (for registered students): **50 EURO** (if student is the first author).

On request, late registration fee could be paid at the registration desk with the approval of the organizing committee.

The registration fee includes the conference proceeding, admission to the technical sessions, conference banquet and coffee breaks.

The organizers can accept the payment of reduced registration fees for authors and for members of professional societies upon request.

Papers will be published in the conference proceedings, only if at least one of the authors pays the registration fee.

Upon receiving the acceptance of the authors, selected papers will be published in the “**Scientific Bulletin of POLITEHNICA University of Timișoara, Romania - Transactions on Automatic Control and Computer Science**” Journal (ISSN 1224-600X).

SPECIAL SESSIONS (proposed by contributors)

Special sessions will include 4-5 invited papers. These papers should present a cohesive and comprehensive discussion of a relevant topic, consistent with the conference topics.

Prospective organizers are invited to submit by e-mail the proposed session title and the extended (two pages) abstracts or the full papers. Deadline for submission is 3.04.2006. The acceptance of the special session will be notified on 5.04.2006. For the submission of full papers see IMPORTANT DEADLINES.

REGULAR PAPERS

Are requested in all areas consistent with the conference topics. Authors are asked to submit their work by uploading it on the conference web-site the full papers of 4 or 6 pages length in electronic form (<http://conti.ac.upt.ro/>).

Authors are requested to clearly point out - at paper submission and e-mail correspondence, *the code and name of the topic* to which their paper is submitted to (e.g., 1. Control engineering: theory and applications).
